



- 3 Endorse your checks and take pictures with phone as directed.
- 4 Submit!

Within seconds you'll see confirmation that the deposit was received—it's that easy!

If you are interested in being a candidate for the WFCU Board of Directors please review the minimum requirements and qualifications below and submit a brief description, 200 words or less, of your board of director qualifications no later than August 31, 2017 to WFCU: Attention: Betty Crawford, Director of Human Resources, 318 5th Avenue, South Charleston, WV 25303.

Your Qualification letter will be forwarded to the Nominating Committee. Please carefully review the expected duty of care as a WVFCU Board of Director.

WVFCU Board of Director Requirements:

- 1.) Participation in each scheduled monthly meeting.
- 2.) Serve on various credit union committees which meet periodically during the year.
- 3.) Attend various credit union educational sessions as required.
- 4.) Meet Insurer Bonding requirements.
- 5.) Must be able to demonstrate personal financial responsibility.
- 6.) Meet the financial literacy requirements of the NCUA.
- 7.) Adhere to the WVFCU conflict of interest policy.
- 8.) Commit to serve a three-year term.

Details regarding voting will be presented in the December 2017 Quarterly Newsletter. Voting will be conducted by electronic ballot, which members may access by visiting <a href="www.wyfcu.org">www.wyfcu.org</a>. There will be no nominations from the floor or voting at the annual meeting.

#### **Family Camp**

#### Medomak Camp · Rockland, Maine

Mom and Dad join in the pranks and games with a nostalgic week at family sleepaway camp. A flat tuition fee for <a href="Medomak camp">Medomak camp</a> covers activities and all meals in a gournet mess hall, including a lobster feast. Morning activities for the kids might include archery or arts and crafts while adults practice yoga, get a massage or even join the kids for some craft time. In the afternoon, everyone heads to the lake for swimming, kayaking, sculling or sailing. Come nightfall, the whole family can set off on a scavenger hunt or play softball or ultimate Frisbee. #### Ace Adventure Center · Oak Hill, West Virginia

Carve some family bonding time into summer with wild outdoor adventures for one set price at <u>Ace Adventure Center</u>. Ace boasts a prime location on the New River Gorge National River, known as the East Coast's Grand Canyon. Children as young as 6 can join the family for a daylong white-water adventure along some easy class II and III rapids. Zip-line tours, horseback-riding, kayaking and rock-climbing are available for an extra fee. Back at base camp, there's wild water-park fun with inflatables on the lake for no extra charge; hiking on any of the resort's trails is free as well. Lodging ranges from rustic camping to cozy log cabins and lakeside chalets.

#### Maho Bay Camps • St John, US Virgin Islands

As the temperature rises in the Caribbean during the summer, airfare and hotel rates take a dip. Between May and December, Maho Bay Camps on St. John is a summer bargain for families -- kids under 16 stay free with paying adults. Embark on a modern Swiss Family Robinson adventure at this eco-resort camp with platform tents connected by a series of wooden walkways. The beach alone offers enough fun to keep the kids busy with swimming, sailing and snorkeling in the waters protected by the US Virgin Islands National Park. At the Trash to Treasures Art Center, budding artists create "green" masterpieces from recycled goods and natural elements like seashell wind chimes.

#### **Boston, Massachusetts**

Shake up the summer routine with an urban getaway to <u>Boston</u>. Summer in the city is the perfect time to enjoy the harbor and outdoor parks. With no slush and snow underfoot, it's a great time for a picnic on the Boston Commons or a stroll along the Freedom Trail. The <u>Landmark Orchestra</u> plays free concerts on Wednesday nights at Hatch Memorial Shell. A <u>Go Boston card</u> is a money-saving essential with free and discounted admission to over 70 attractions, museums and tours in the area. Take a cruise on Boston Harbor, catch a baseball game at <u>Fenway Park</u> or head out of town to nearby <u>Six Flags New England and Hurricane Harbor</u> and attractions at nearby Cape Cod.
