



COPPA Policy Disclosure

The Children’s Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) restricts the collection, use or disclosure of Personal Information from and about children under the age of 13 on the internet. In compliance with COPPA, West Virginia Federal Credit Union (the “credit union”) is committed to protecting the online privacy of the children who visit our website. The credit union’s website and online services are not directed to children under the age of 13, nor is personally identifiable information knowingly collected from children under the age of 13. Should the credit union receive personally identifiable information (name, address, email, account number, telephone and/or social security number) regarding a child known to be under the age of 13, the information will only be used to respond to the child directly, seek parental consent to provide parental notice. The credit union is not responsible for the data collection and use practices of nonaffiliated third parties.
